BRING PUBLIC HEALTH TO THE TABLE

Does current proposed legislation address the following?

- Childhood poisonings from ingesting edibles
- Prevention of marijuana use in schools
- Increase mental health and social services for schools & communities
- Increased car fatalities due to additional impaired drivers
- Need for additional drug treatment programs
- Marketing tactics used to target underage users and pregnant women
- Recreational use & employment (Commercial Driver License)
- NJ Smoke Free Air Act -- only addresses tobacco/nicotine
